Previously he was a faculty member in the Statistics Department at Temple University, and he has held visiting positions at the Radiation Effects Research Foundation in Hiroshima and at the Division of Cancer Epidemiology and Genetics at the National Cancer Institute. He is a coauthor on more than 100 publications in biostatistics, genetics, proteomics, and cancer biology.
