



Virtual Faculty Workshop in Mentoring Biomedical Grad Students and Postdocs

Even faculty who have mentored dozens of graduate students and postdocs can always improve their skills in mentoring. This advanced topics workshop will use lessons and cases from the Center for the Improvement of Mentored Experiences in Research (CIMER) for active learning (participation required) on the topics of 1) aligning expectations, 2) promoting effective communication and 3) promoting professional development.
