Dear CTSA Workforce Development Enterprise Committee Members,

We are delighted to invite your scholars/trainees to participate in the **Clinical Trials Boot Camp**, a 5-day, in-person training program held at Lilly Corporate Center in Indianapolis.

Purpose

You would join an immersive pilot program designed for **Clinical Research Physicians and Scientists** who are new to their role or new to Lilly.

Through workshops, interactive lectures, and panel discussions, the Boot Camp offers a hands-on introduction to how Lilly designs, runs, and delivers clinical trials.

The goals of the Boot Camp are to:

- Provide a comprehensive overview of Lilly's clinical development model
- Increase understanding of the full drug development lifecycle from pre-clinical to post-market surveillance
- Enhance skillsets in developing high quality robust clinical trial protocols

You will be the first participants to go through the program, and as such your feedback will be important to help shape the program moving forward. A high level overview of the topics to be covered during the boot camp are attached to this email.

The course will run from Monday to Friday, 8am to 430pm.

***Following the 5-day Boot Camp, you'll participate in a series of virtual sessions over the next 4–6 months designed to reinforce and expand on the core concepts introduced during the course.**

Eligibility:

Limited to CTSA early career scientists, KL2/K12 scholars or postdoctoral trainees with at least one year remaining on their appointment.

Applicants must have a M.D., or Ph.D. or other clinical doctoral degree

Applicants must be US citizens or permanent residents

Application requirements:

- Curriculum vitae
- Cover letter, explaining interest, research and professional development goals (2-3 pages double spaced max)
- Letter of support from CTSA KL2/K12 PI or TL1/T32 PI

Applications are due by **11:59pm EST, Thursday, September 25, 2025**, and should be emailed to Dr. Joan Nagel at ncatselilillyexternship@mail.nih.gov

We anticipate notifying the accepted applicant by October 2, 2025.
