MEC-CUNY undergraduates:
90% African American, 72% female, average age 27;

NJCU undergraduates:
34% Hispanic, 21% African American, 60% female, average age 25;

WPU undergraduates:
32% Hispanic, 17% African American, 30% 1st generation
