Using technology to engage Adolescent and Young Adult (AYA) cancer survivors in health interventions

Dr. Devine is a clinical psychologist and Associate Professor of Pediatrics at Rutgers Robert Wood Johnson Medical School. She serves as the Section Chief of Pediatric Population Science, Outcomes, and Disparities Research at the Rutgers Cancer Institute of New Jersey. In this seminar, Dr. Devine will discuss the unique needs of adolescent and young adult (AYA) survivors of childhood cancer and challenges in recruiting and retaining AYA survivors in research. She will present the development and evaluation of an online self-management and peer mentoring intervention designed to empower AYA survivors to take responsibility for their healthcare as they transition from pediatric to adult healthcare settings.
